What is the Training?

NYLT is a six-day outdoor experience for Boy Scouts and Venturers (male and female). It supports the Unit Leader's responsibility for training the unit's youth leaders. The Pacific Skyline Council conducts the Training based on an outline approved by the National Council, Boy Scouts of America.

What is its purpose?

The Training has three aims. The first is to relate the Scout's/Venturer's unit job to the skills of leadership that have proven effective in a variety of Scouting and personal leadership situations. The second is to give participants a chance to relate to leaders from other units for an exchange of ideas and experiences. The third is to give each participant a varied experience in Scoutcraft skills that can be shared with members of their unit.

Who may attend?

The Training is open to registered Boy Scouts and Venturers (male and female) who:

- Boy Scouts who will be 14 years old as of June 9, 2012 and have at least the First Class rank
- Boy Scouts who are 13½ years of age will be considered on a case by case basis
- Venturers (male and female) who will be 14 years old as of June 9, 2012
- Recommended by the Scoutmaster/Venture Leader as being ready to assume a senior leadership position

10:30 A.M. Saturday, June 9, 2012 to 10:30 A.M. Friday, June 15, 2012

Boulder Creek Scout Reservation. Participants from the same troop/crew are encouraged to carpool.

What is the cost?

\$225 This includes all food, team equipment, and training materials.

How to apply?
